Subject: Transfer of motor vehicle within the State.

Reference on the subject cited above.

2. The transfer of a motor vehicle takes place due to change of address of residence or place of business or where the vehicle is normally kept for business. As per the provisions of sections 48, 49 and 50 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, no-objection certificate (NOC) is required in case of transfer of motor vehicle outside the State.
3. It is observed that unnecessary changes in registering authorities at the time of transfer of motor vehicle within the State leads to unnecessary difficulties in proper record-keeping of the motor vehicle and sometimes the practise is misused by unscrupulous elements to re-register a stolen motor vehicle.
4. It is hereby directed, therefore, that on change of address within the State, the original Registering Authority may continue to service requests from the owner or the transferee, as the case may be. There is no need to insist that the vehicle be got transferred to a new registering authority within the State. In rare cases, where the vehicle owner or the transferee wishes to transfer the motor vehicle to another registering authority within the State, such request may be allowed after a thorough scrutiny that all due taxes and fees are paid, the vehicle is insured and has a valid fitness certificate.
5. The new registering authority shall cross-check the physical NOC or Clearance certificate in the case of transfer from outside or within the State respectively with the data available on the vahaan web-portal before effecting the transfer. Due caution shall be taken that the motor vehicle is not a stolen vehicle.
