Minutes of the meeting of State Road Safety Council held on 11.05.2016 at 12.00 Noon under the Chairmanship of Sh. Krishan Lal Panwar, Hon'ble Transport Minister, Haryana.

A meeting of the State Road Safety Council was held on 11.05.2016 at 12.00 Noon at Haryana Niwas, Sector-3, Chandigarh under the Chairmanship of Sh. Krishan Lal Panwar, Hon'ble Transport Minister, Haryana. The list of participants is enclosed as Annexure-A.

2- At the outset, Dr. Suprabha Dahiya, IAS, Transport Commissioner welcomed the Hon'ble Transport Minister, Haryana and the participants. Addressing the participants, she stated that a total of 11174 accidents occurred during the year 2015 and 4879 people died and 10794 were injured. There has been an increase in the number of accidents and fatal injuries as compared to the previous years. Therefore, more road safety measures are required to be taken to reduce the number of road accidents. All the departments need to put in more concerted efforts in order to make a visible impact.

Agenda Item No. 1- Review of the decisions taken in the last meeting of the State Road Safety Council held on 16.06.2015.

Sh. S.S. Dhillon, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary, Transport stated that as per the action taken report:

Out of total 1170 identified points, 1078 accident prone points have been rectified till 16.02.2016. Of the remaining points, 86 relate to PWD (B&R), one to Power Department and 5 to State Transport Department. Sh. Anoop Chauhan, Chief Engineer, PWD (B&R) assured that efforts will be made to rectify the remaining 86 points within the next three months i.e. by 10.08.2016. The Power and State Transport Department will also complete work on their pending points within the next three months i.e. by 10.08.2016. The Additional DGP (Law & Order) stated that the fresh survey of the accident prone points was conducted by them and 157 fresh workable points have been identified by them (2012-2014) and report had been submitted to the Transport Department vide letter No. 11776 dated 21.12.2015. Sh. Vipin Sharma, General

Manager/ Project Director, NHAI, Ambala intimated that work of 6 laning on NH-1 from Panipat to Jalandhar (Km 96 to Km 387.10, total length Km 291 in Haryana State) has been allotted and work will be started soon. Panipat elevated corridor has been completed. 6 laning work related to Namaste Chowk, Karnal has been completed and work related to Baldi Chowk, Karnal is in progress and will be completed within next three months.

Agenda Item No. 2- Rectification of Accident Prone Points and identification of new Accident Prone Points.

The Additional DGP (Law & Order) stated that out of 1170 identified points, 1078 accident prone points have been rectified till 16.02.2016. Of the remaining points, 86 relate to PWD (B&R), one to Power Department and 5 to State Transport Department. Sh. Anoop Chauhan, Chief Engineer, PWD (B&R) assured that efforts will be made to rectify the remaining 86 points within the next three months i.e. by 10.08.2016. The Power and State Transport Department will also complete work on their pending points within the next three months i.e. by 10.08.2016. The Additional DGP (Law & Order) stated that the fresh survey of the accident prone points was conducted by them and 157 fresh workable points have been identified by them (2012-2014) and report had been submitted to the Transport Department vide letter No. 11776 dated 21.12.2015. Transport Commissioner informed that no fresh survey report has been received from the Police Department. Thereupon, the ACS (T) was very annoyed with Sh. Sarabjit Singh for stating that letter no. 11776 dated 21.12.2015 was not received in Transport Department and desired that his displeasure should be recorded for the negligent and irresponsible behavior of Publicity Officer (Road Safety).

(Action by Police, PWD(B&R), Power & Transport)

Agenda Item No. 3- Construction of Speed Breakers and identification of new Speed breaker points.

Total 1051 speed breakers have been identified, out of which 915 speed-breakers have been constructed up to 16.02.2016. EIC, PWD (B&R) stated that the

remaining 136 speed-breakers will be completed within next three months i.e. by 10.08.2016. It was pointed out by the Additional Chief Secretary, (Transport) that too many speed breakers have been constructed on NH/SH/MDRs especially in Rohtak, Jind, Bhiwani, Panipat and Sonapat Districts which are a major cause of fatal accidents. The representative PWD (B&R) was directed to re-construct the speed breakers as per IRC Standards wherever required. In case Police help is required for removal of speed breakers, the PWD (B&R) and NHAI will take the help of the concerned Deputy Commissioner/Superintendent of Police. A letter will be written to all the Deputy Commissioners and Superintendents of Police to extend all support to NHAI and PWD (B&R). The ADGP (Law & Order) furnished a list of 86 points for improvement of junctions and roads. The list was handed over to Chief Engineer PWD (B&R), Transport and Power Department for compliance.

(Action by PWD (B&R), NHAI, Police, Transport, Power, DC & SP)

Agenda Item No. 4- Installation of Road signages, Markings, Cat eyes etc.

Regarding installation of road signages, road marking, Cat eyes etc., HUDA, PWD (B&R), Police and NHAI will conduct a fresh survey in urban and rural areas and submit the list within next three months i.e. by 10.08.2016.

(Action by PWD (B&R), HUDA, NHAI & Police)

Agenda Item No. 5- Construction of Foot over bridges and under bridges.

The Project Director, NHAI stated that work on the construction of foot-over-bridges and under bridges on NH-1 (Panipat to Jalandhar) is in progress. Worthy ACS (T) desired that CGM, NHAI may be requested to intimate the latest position of the work to be done on NH-1. Hon'ble Transport Minister observed that there is an urgent requirement of a foot-over-bridge on National Highway at Village Israna (District Panipat). He also directed that the junction needs to be improved to prevent accidents. ADGP (L&O) pointed out that there are too many cuts abutting the Sonapat district stretch of NH-1 which are not required. It was desired to explore the possibility of

construction of foot-over-bridges. ADGP (L&O) further suggested that in order to bring down the traffic jams in Panipat City, vacant space adjoining the pillars may be utilized for widening the road on the pattern of work being done at Zirakpur fly-over. The Transport Department will send reference to NHAI for exploring the possibility for providing additional foot-over-bridges on all the National Highways in the State.

It was observed by ACS (T) that Project Director, NHAI, NH-1 is present in the meeting and he has no information related to the other National Highways in the State. He directed that in future letter be sent to the Chairman, NHAI requesting him to depute either one representative who has the information about all the National Highways of the State or all the Project Directors be directed to attend this meeting.

(Action by NHAI & Police)

Agenda Item No. 6- Installation of Traffic lights at important places.

It was observed that work regarding installation of 47 Traffic Lights has been very slow. Out of 47 Traffic Lights identified in the last meeting of State Road Safety Council held on 16.06.2015, only six traffic lights have been installed by HUDA in district Rewari (3), Rohtak (2) and Faridabad (1). The ULB, PWD (B&R), HUDA & NHAI were directed to ensure installation of all the traffic lights within next three months positively i.e. by 10.08.2016. All the Deputy Commissioners will be directed to ensure timely implementation of the same and to review the same in the District Road Safety Committee meetings on monthly basis.

(Action by HUDA, PWD (B&R), ULB, NHAI & Transport)

Agenda Item No. 7- Provision of Trauma Care facilities in all important hospitals along the Highways.

It was intimated by Deputy Director, O/o DGHS that the proposal for establishment of 13 Trauma Care Centers has already been sent to MoHFW, GOI and the same is likely to be sanctioned by August, 2016. It was directed that the Trauma Care Centers should be made functional by August, 2017. It was further desired that list

of all Govt. Hospitals, Private Hospitals on National Highways, along with names of Nodal officers and their contact numbers should be displayed on National Highways/State Highways/Major District Roads including Toll Plazas, Police Control Rooms and websites of Transport, Health, NHAI and Police Department. It may also be ensured that ambulances with Paramedical Staff on National Highways are deployed for carrying road accident victims to the nearest trauma care centers.

(Action by Health, Police, NHAI & Transport)

Agenda Item No. 8- Removal of liquor shops and Ahatas from Highways.

It was intimated by Smt. Amrita Singh, HCS, Additional Excise & Taxation Commissioner that all the liquor shops on National/State Highways have been removed and there is no violation at present. It was further directed to intimate the development in SLP (C) No. 8971 of 2014 filled by the State in the Hon'ble Supreme Court as the information is required to be furnished to the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety by 30.06.2016.

(Action by Excise & Taxation Department)

Agenda Item No. 9- Review of District Road Safety Committee meetings held from 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2016.

It was observed that the District Road Safety Committee meetings are required to be held on monthly basis but are not being held regularly. It was decided that all the Deputy Commissioners be directed to ensure that meetings are held every month and proceedings are sent to the Transport Commissioner office regularly.

(Action by DCs & RTAs)

Agenda Item No. 10- Inclusion of Road Safety Education in school curriculum and community education initiatives.

Representative of School Education Department informed that Road Safety Education has been included in the school curriculum from class 3rd to 10th and proposal for inclusion of the same for classes 11th and 12th has been sent to National

Council for Educational Research and Training (NCERT), New Delhi for approval for the session 2016-17. Sh. Sushil Arya, Member of State Road Safety Council proposed that seminars on necessity of wearing of helmets may be organized in schools and colleges. Necessary directions will be issued in this regard.

(Action by Education, Police & Transport)

Other Items-

1- It was apprised by the Transport Commissioner that Software for Road Safety Information System is being developed so that all related information is readily available. The proposal for creation of additional posts in Road Safety Wing in Transport Commissioner's office is being submitted to the Government, as per the directions of Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety.

(Action by Transport Department)

2- The Transport Commissioner informed the members about the various directions of the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety conveyed vide their letter no. 31/CoRS/2014 dated 27.04.2016. The information is required to be furnished to the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety on or before 30.06.2016:

a) SPECIFIC ACTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH STREET VENDORS ACT, 2014:

Chief Engineer, Urban Local Bodies informed that policy regarding Street Vendors (Protection of livelihood and regulation of street vending) Act, 2014 has been formulated and sent to the Government for approval. It was directed that HUDA should also form similar policy within a time bound manner.

(Action by ULB & HUDA)

**b) CREATION OF ADDITIONAL POSTS AND RECRUITMENT IN TRAFFIC WING,
POLICE DEPTT., HARYANA:**

It was informed by ADGP (L&O) that the recruitment of 7200 Police personnel is under consideration of the State Government. The traffic wing will be equipped with more staff as and when the recruitment is completed.

(Action by DGP)

c) CONDUCTING ROAD SAFETY AUDIT:

It was informed by the Chief Engineer, HUDA that steps are being taken to get Road Safety Audit conducted by M/s DIMTS of District Gurgaon presently. PWD (B&R), HUDA and ULB were directed to conduct Road Safety Audit at design, construction and operational stages.

(Action by HUDA, ULB & PWD (B&R))

**d) INFORMATION REGARDING TRAINING OF HIGHWAY ENGINEERS IN ROAD
SAFETY:**

PWD (B&R), HUDA and ULB were directed to send information on the number of Highway Engineers trained in Road Safety along with their names, duration and description of training. They will also intimate further schedule of training of the other staff by these master trainers.

(Action by HUDA, ULB & PWD (B&R))

e) CALMING MEASURES ON HIGHWAYS:

Regarding speed calming measures, NHAI, PWD (B&R), HUDA and ULB were directed to explore the possibility of illusionary speed breakers on the pattern of State of Gujarat.

(Action by HUDA, ULB, PWD (B&R) & NHAI)

f) DISPLAY OF SHORT FILMS/CLIPS:

Regarding display of short films/clips on Road Safety in all the Cinema Halls, all the Deputy Commissioners and Direction General, Information, Public Relation & Cultural Affairs department will be directed to ensure time bound compliance.

(Action by Transport, all DCs & DPR)

g) PROVIDING LATEST DATA:

NHAI, Police, PWD (B&R), ULB and HUDA were directed to send data regarding total number of accidents, grievous injuries and fatalities in respect of each Black Spot on National Highways, State Highways, Major District Roads or other roads for the last three years and estimated expenditure for rectification of the same. The report should be sent within 07 days positively.

(Action by NHAI, Police, PWD(B&R), ULB & HUDA)

h) CHALLANING AND SUSPENSION OF DRIVING LICENSES:

The Police and Transport Department were directed to ensure the compliance of directions of Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety regarding Challaning and Suspension of Driving Licences for a period of not less than three months under Section 19 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 read with Rule 21 of the Central

Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 for offences such as Over Speeding, Red Light Jumping, Carrying over load in Goods Carriage and carrying persons in Goods Carriages, driving vehicles under the influence of drinks and drugs, using Mobile Phones while driving.

(Action by Police, Transport, RTAs & RAs)

i) PROTECTION TO GOOD SAMARITANS:

It was directed to ensure compliance of guidelines issued by the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways relating to protection of Good Samaritans. The Police and Health Department were directed to ensure that no harassment is caused to the persons who carry road accident victims to the hospitals.

(Action by Police & Health)

3- Sh. Sushil Arya, Member of the State Road Safety Council submitted a very impressive presentation on Road Safety issues. It was directed that the same may be forwarded to Police, PWD (B&R), ULB, HUDA for rectification of accident prone points, improving visibility on major/minor roads, removal of abandoned bus queue shelters and trees, removal of unauthorized encroachment on road berms and highways, parking issue adjoining in banks buildings in main bazaars/main roads, proposal for construction of road on NH-73A at Lal Dhang near HP border, Kalesar, Yamuna Nagar.

(Action by Police, NHAI, PWD (B&R), ULB & HUDA)













4- Sh. Rajiv Ranjan, Member of State Road Safety Council suggested that the department should bring out journal "Yatayat Prahari" incorporating the activities under taken by the Transport Department in the direction of Road Safety as a public awareness initiative.

(Action by Transport)

5- It was desired by the Hon'ble Transport Minister, Haryana that funds allocated for road safety awareness should be spent by the Secretary, RTAs/Police in a time bound manner and trainings in schools, colleges, technical institutes should be conducted on regular basis. Joint checking by Forest, PWD (B&R), ULB, HUDA and Police should be conducted for removal of unauthorized structures. It was further desired that eye check-up of drivers should be conducted from time to time and certificate be issued at the time of renewal of Driving Licence. Strict checking should be done by traffic police to check offence of use mobile phone while driving. Informatory sign boards shall be erected at prominent places. The compliance report be submitted within one month positively. The Hon'ble Transport Minister expressed his displeasure over non-participation of the official members in the meeting. He desired that this lapse be brought to the notice of the Chief Secretary. He also directed that in future members of the State Road Safety Council will attend the meeting in person and not through their representatives. No non-member will be allowed to participate in the meeting in future.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
