Subject: Writ Petition (Civil) No.295 of 2012 – Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 30th November, 2017 on road safety

Sir,

As per the information provided by you in the compliance report on the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 30th November, 2017, the Committee had prepared a Statement showing the compliance reported by you on each item and had submitted the Statement to the Hon'ble Supreme Court. A copy of the same is annexed (**Annexure**).

2. The matter came up for hearing in the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 12th July, 2018. The Hon'ble Court had observed that certain compliance has not been made by some of the States/UTs and had desired that this Committee should ask them to comply with those directions which have not yet been fully complied with by them.
3. The last column of the Statement referred to above indicates the observations of the Committee, on the basis of your Report, as to whether the directions have been fully complied with or not by you.

4. The Committee now directs that those directions which have not yet been fully complied with by you must be complied with fully without further delay. A Report on the compliance by you should be forwarded to the Committee latest by **31st August, 2018** to enable the Committee to apprise the Hon'ble Supreme Court of the States/UTs which are still in default.
