Sub: Committee on Road Safety-Furnishing of compliance report

Sir,

Kindly refer to your letter No. 2086/AT-8/RSB dated 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 furnishing compliance report on the measures taken as per the directions of the Committee on Road Safety vide its letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> December, 2014.

2. The measures taken by you have been examined by the Committee in detail. The Committee has the following observations:

<u>Item No.</u>	Observation of the Committee
(i)	The Committee has noted that the State had set up a Road Safety Council on 12.03.98 and reconstituted the same on 23.7.14. However, no meeting of the reconstituted Council seems to be held so far. Its 1 <sup>st</sup> meeting may be held before 30 <sup>th</sup> June, 2015 and the Minutes be forwarded to the Committee. Thereafter, meetings of the Committee should be held at least twice a year and the Minutes of the meetings and the Action Taken Reports on the decisions taken by the Council be sent to the Committee regularly.
(ii)	Noted.
(iii)	The Committee has noted the action taken by the State in respect of black spots.  The Committee also wants the State to draw up an annual calendar for identification of black spots, allocation of funds/approval of projects for rectification and monitoring of the action taken.
(iv)	Noted. Committee wants to know as to when 21 posts of M.V Officers and 42 Transport-Sub-Inspectors sanctioned for enforcement would be filled up. The specific steps taken for assessment of requirement of equipments for detecting traffic violations may also be indicated.
(v)	Action taken by the Police Department and PWD (B&R) on Highway patrolling and engineering measures required may be intimated to the Committee.
(vi)	Details of traffic calming measures taken by the PWD (B&R) department may be intimated
(vii)	Action Taken by the Excise & Taxation Department for putting ban on sale of alcohol on State and National Highways may be forwarded to the Committee.
(viii)	Action Taken by Urban Local bodies to remove

	hoardings and objects that obstruct driving or distract drivers may be intimated.
(ix)	Present status of setting up of Road Safety Fund may be indicated.
(x)	Status in regard to the implementation of schemes sanctioned by MoRTH/MHA/MoH&FW for the State of Haryana be furnished.
(xi)	Road Safety Action Plan be redrafted by 30 <sup>th</sup> June, 2015 and forwarded to MoRTH with a copy to the Committee.
(xii)	Action Taken by Local bodies for removal of encroachments on pedestrian paths may be intimated.

2. You are requested to kindly take action as advised above and forward the compliance report to the Committee in respect of each direction by **30<sup>th</sup> June**, **2015**.
