The Transport Department Haryana, established under section 213 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, implements the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. The functions of the office of the Transport Commissioner include registration of motor vehicles, issue of driving licenses, grant of permits, checking of offences by motor vehicles and drivers, road safety etc.

### **OBJECTIVES**

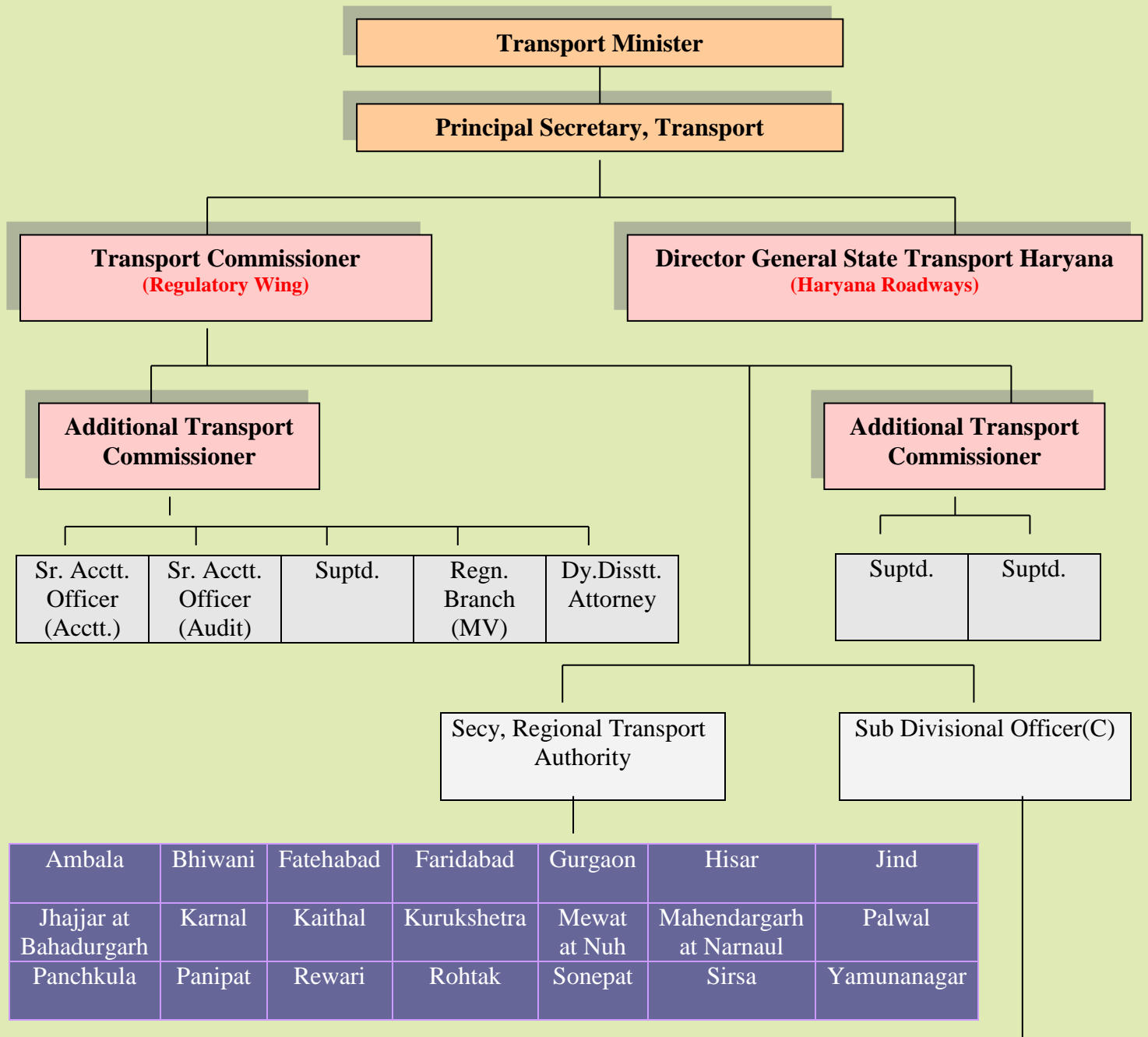
1. Improved Efficiency and Outreach of Public Transport Services.

7. making stage carriage schemes;

9. collection of taxes and fees;
10. enforcement of the provisions regarding offences by motor vehicles.
